

Hartland Lakeside 2018-19 Student Academic Standards Parental Notice

The Hartland Lakeside School District has established K-8 student academic standards/learning targets in reading, writing, mathematics, science, geography, and history. The standards/learning targets in reading, writing, and mathematics align with the *Common Core State Standards* formerly adapted to Wisconsin by the Department of Public Instruction. The science learning targets reflect *Next Generation Science Standards*, while the geography and history standards align with *Wisconsin Academic Standards*.

School Accountability

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) issues a School Report Card and a District Report Card for every public school and district in Wisconsin. The Hartland Lakeside School District received the following scores:

LIFE Charter – 95.0 – Significantly Exceeds Expectations
North Shore Middle School – 98.5 – Significantly Exceeds Expectations

*Hartland North and HFALA do not receive school report card grades. But in comparison, 96% of students in grades 5K-2nd grade met or exceeded grade level expectations in literacy at the end of the 2016-17 school year. Reading proficiency at Hartland North and Hartland Fine Arts is 92%.

For the 2018-2019 school year, there is no School Report Card information available on other independent Charter Schools, or K-8 Elementary private schools participating in a private choice program located within the Hartland Lakeside School District boundaries.
