

# DETERMINING ACCEPTABLE CLASSROOM FOODS & EVENT FOODS

Is product homemade?

Exceptions are permitted for cheese and fresh produce for individual student snacks. Any cheese or fresh produce that is to be shared in class, or at any school event, must be prepared (washed and cut up) at school in a nut safe environment.

Does product have a commercial label?

Foods that are purchased at a store bakery are only acceptable if they are specifically labeled as being peanut and tree nut free. While bakery items may have an ingredient label, this type of product is exempt from labeling standards that would disclose any potential cross contamination with peanuts or tree nuts during baking or packaging. Bakery products without this specific labeling are not acceptable for classroom snacking.
