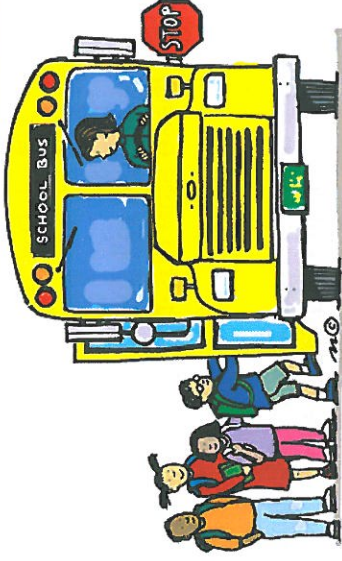

# SCHOOL BUS SAFETY INFORMATION



A REMINDER FOR

### Discussion Points

Parents should talk to their children about these safe bus-riding guidelines.



Keep all their items in a backpack or school bag to avoid dropping things especially around the bus



Have them wear clothes that make it easy to see them or attach strips of reflective tape on their backpacks or outerwear



Have them leave home on time to avoid running for a bus – they should always be a the stop 5 minutes early



Have them stay in groups and never talk to strangers – instruct them to tell a driver or parent if they see a stranger anywhere near the bus



Remind them not to “horseplay” around the bus; it is dangerous and someone could get seriously hurt (possibly slide under the bus)



Tell them to stand at least 10-feet back and never move toward the bus until it has come to a complete stop and has opened the doors.



### Behavior on the Bus

#### Rule #1

Students need to be seated at all times.  
To keep students safe

#### Rule #2

The bus windows are only allowed to be open half-way.  
To keep students safe

#### Rule # 3

Students need to keep their hands to themselves.  
For the respect of others

#### Rule #4

Appropriate language with “inside” voices only, may be used on the bus.  
Loud voices may distract the driver

#### Rule #5

Eating and drinking are not allowed on the bus.  
It may cause a slipping hazard & there are many food allergies

#### Rule # 6

The last two rows of seats should not be used unless the bus is full.  
BACK SEATS SHOULD STAY EMPTY WHENEVER POSSIBLE



### Entering/Exiting the Bus



Always listen to the driver and watch for his/her hand signal before crossing the road.



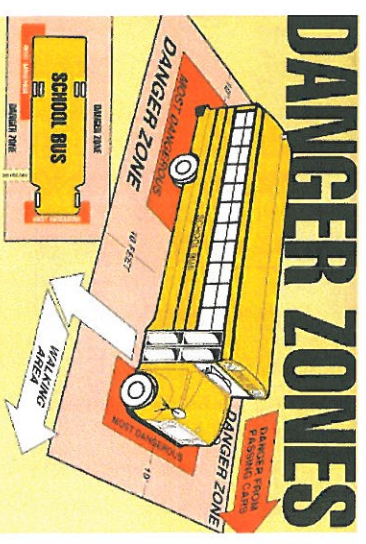
Always pause to look both ways before getting off the bus and before crossing the street in front of the bus.



Always have a note signed by the office if you plan to get off at a different stop than your own.

Once you leave the bus, do not come back to the bus ... for any reason.

Always stay out of the “DANGER ZONE” around the bus



If you drop something, have the driver get it for you or wait for a parent to help you after the bus leaves.
