

3K Frequently Asked Questions

If my child turns 3 during the school year, can my child attend the 3K program mid year?

All students enrolled in our 3K program must be three years old by Sept. 1.

Will my child get into the program?

It is first come, first served due to limited seats available. However, we will have a waitlist and if a seat opens up, we will contact the family.

Do you provide transportation for the 3K program?

We do not provide transportation for our 3K students.

Does my child need to be potty trained?

We are requiring that the children are potty trained to enter our 3K program. We do however understand that there will be accidents.

Why is there a cost associated with the 3K preschool program?

3K is not funded by the state, therefore, in order to offer this preschool option to our families, we have to self fund the program to pay for the cost of running it and to pay the teaching staff. The cost for each day is \$25.00. Parents can choose the days they want their child in the program.

Will you be offering a before and after school care and a wrap around care option?

Yes, we will offer a before and after school care option from 6:00am-9:00am and 4:00pm-6:00pm. This will be staffed by our 3K staff and will be in the same room as our 3K preschool and wrap around program. The cost is \$10.00 for before and \$10.00 for after or \$20.00 if you opt for both before and after.

The wrap around option will be daily from 12:00pm-4:00pm. This is offered to parents who need a full day of care. They will be combined with our 4K wrap around program. The students will be able to have lunch at school and have play time, rest time and continued socialization. The cost of our wrap around program is \$20.00 per day.

Does the 3K program follow our district calendar?

Yes, our 3K program will follow the district/4K calendar. On non-student days there will be no 3K. There will also not be 3K on the district early release days, which occur once a month on Thursdays. Please see district calendar for details.
